More than 22,500 tons of materials were recycled in Greensboro in 2005! You can be a part of this earth-friendly effort by using your **brown** City recycling can properly. Simply follow the guidelines below.

Recyclables should be dry with no food or grease. It is not necessary to remove labels, but caps and lids should be thrown away. If you are not sure if something can be recycled, call 373-2489 to find out.

Items that can be recycled include:



Plastic bottles

(No jars or other plastic materials regardless of number)



Glass bottles & jars



Steel & tin cans



Aerosol cans



Newspapers



Magazines



Office paper



Cardboard

(no pizza boxes)



Chip Board

(thin gray/brown cardboard)



Aluminum cans
